

VACANCY OR UNOCCUPANCY PERMIT

We grant permission for the premises described in this policy to remain _____ for the
"Vacant" or "Unoccupied"
period beginning _____ and ending _____ .
Month/Day/Year Month/Day/Year

"Vacant" means: 1. an empty dwelling without anyone residing there, or
2. a building not in use.

"Unoccupied" means a dwelling that is furnished but temporarily no one is residing there.

It is required, as a part of this permit, that the premises be kept properly closed and secured to prevent trespassing or the entrance of unauthorized persons during the period indicated above.

If this policy includes the perils of Vandalism and Malicious Mischief, and if the premises are vacant, this permit does not alter the provisions of these perils.

All other provisions of this policy apply.
